

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual AEROPATH Meeting held on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2011

The AEROPATH Consortium held its 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Meeting at the Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2011.
